FOR ALL TRAVELERS

- ▶ All Travelers must complete and submit a health declaration and health surveillance forms as well as provide details of their itinerary to Port Health Officials upon arrival. They will be subjected to screening by Port Health Officials upon arrival and departure.
- ▶ All PCR test reports must be presented to the Namibian authority in English.
- ▶ Tourist must acquire travel insurance that covers medical care in event of unexpected extended stay in Namibia.
- ▶ All travelers should wear masks at all times whilst within the Ports of Entry controlled area and in public.
- ▶ Tourists are permitted to use only NTB registered or health certified tourism facilities.
- ▶ Entry into Namibia will be allowed via the Hosea Kutako and Walvisbay International Airports and the Ariamsvlei, Noordoewer and Katima Mulilo land border posts and any other as may be announced from time to time.
- ▶ Tourists must adhere to the VISA requirements applicable to their countries.
- ▶ Travelers will further be subjected to other formal immigration processes on arrival.
- ▶ Travelers other than tourists are outside the dispensation of the TRI and are subjected to the requirements as stipulated in the Public Health Covid-19 General Regulations and Public Environmental Health Act, 2015 issued under Government Gazette No. 233, 235 and 256
- ▶ To meet the Aviation industry requirements and in order to be allowed boarding on any airplane outgoing travelers should ensure that they are tested as per the requirement of the airline. List of Centres can be found at www.namibiatourism.com.na

TRAVELERS COMING FOR TOURISM

- ▶ If you have a negative SARS CoV2 PCR test not older than 72 hours from time the specimen was collected to time of boarding a plane to Namibia :
 - ▶ You will be allowed entry into Namibia and be permitted to proceed to the booked destination and continue with the holiday itinerary in the country.
 - ▶ You do not need to do the mandatory test on day 5
- ▶ If you arrive in Namibia with a negative PCR test that is older than 72 hrs , but not older than 7 days, you will be permitted to enter the country. However, you will be required to undergo 7-days supervised quarantine at tourism facilities of their booking.
- ▶ If you are detected with symptoms will be subjected to further screening and may be required to remain in quarantine until a repeat COVID-19 test is conducted at their own cost.
- ▶ If the result is positive, the tourist will be taken the MOHSS identified isolation facilities and treated at own cost and according to national case management guidelines.

Tourists who do not present a negative PCR test will not be granted entry into Namibia.
